The History of King

Kingman came into being in 1882, although a road was built through the area in 1859, to see if camels could serve as pack animals in the Southwest. Lt. Beale was the builder of this wagon trail, and it became part of Route 66 and today's Interstate 40. The town's modest origin was as a railway siding at Beale's Spring for the new Atlantic and Pacific Railroad. It was named for Lewis Kingman, who surveyed the stretch from Albuquerque to Needles, CA and built the piece from Winslow to Beale's Spring.

One of Kingman's greatest claims to fame is being," The Heart of Historic Route 66 "; the longest still-existing stretch of the old road between Chicago and Los Angeles, it starts west of Ashfork, and continues through Seligman to Peach Springs. Andy Devine, the movie star, was raised in Kingman; his father owned the Beale's Hotel, and the main street is named after him. "Andy Devine Days" are a yearly event.

Kingman is the county seat of Mojave County. After WWII, several large companies established bases here, including Ford, with its proving grounds at the old Yucca Airfield. That, and the arrival of the Duval Copper Mine, the Mojave Generating Station, and the General Cable Plant, contributed to providing a stable employment base for all.

This is a good location from which to explore the Grand Canyon Skywalk, Route 66, Lake Mead, and so many other places; you shouldn't get bored.—George Hirko



What is Healing Fields?

Healing Fields is an event that we volunteer for every year, and is near and dear to our hearts. We help to set up 3,000 8-foot tall American flags, one for each person that lost their life on September 11th, 2001. There is also a bio card included with each flag, so you can read about each person individually.

On September 10th around 5:30 AM several people will gather at the park to pound rebar and set up the flags. That night there will also be a Freedom cert, starting at 6:30 PM. It is free to attend.

The memorial service will take place the very next morning at 5:45 AM. There will also be a candlelight vigil that night at 7 PM. The memorial itself will be open starting September 10th upon completion, and will stay open through September 15th, when we will start taking down the memorial at 6 AM.
