I joined the military in October 6th, 1992, to go fight Saddam Hussein in Iraq. I served in the United States Marine Corps. for 4 years: October 1992 to October 1996. I was in the infantry with the Second Battalion Fifth Marines as an 0351, which is a anti-tank assault gunner, also known as DRAGONS, for 2 years. I then became a 3521 with the 11th Marines, which was a motor transport mechanic, for the other 2 years. Most of my time I was stationed in Camp Pendleton, California but I was also at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina for training as a mechanic. I also did a WESTPAC (deployed overseas) in 1994, to Somalia, for 6 months.

Any branch of the armed forces is good, but like I said, I needed a challenge, so I joined the USMC which is the hardest of them all. Please let us know if you would be available. You can call the office to let the schedulers know which date/time you are available and we will put you in the schedule. Please treat this like a shift, and call us if you can't make it, as we will be depending on you to be there.



Q: I am going to be late or need to cancel my shift. What do I do?

A: The correct procedure, if you know you will be late or need to cancel your shift, is to call the scheduling pager, no matter what time of the day it is. Even if it's during office hours, you still need to call the pager. Not the office, and not shift reporting.
